Croydon Youth Orchestra

The Peter Stark/ Chineke! concert will be a flagship event for the youth orchestra players who will be performing alongside students from the Trinity Music Academy and professional musicians from the Chineke! orchestra. Peter Stark is world-renowned for his work with young orchestras, including the European Union Youth Orchestra where he is resident conductor. In January and February we will be joined by postgraduate students from the Royal College and professional musicians from Chineke!
